INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT: VOLUNTARY AIDED SCHOOL

- 1. The name of the school is St Mary's and St Andrew's Catholic Primary School, Barton Newsham
- 2. The school was founded by and is part of the Catholic Church. The school is to be conducted as a Catholic School in accordance with the Canon Law and teachings of the Roman Catholic Church, and in accordance with the Trust Deed of the Diocese of Lancaster and in particular:
 - (a) Religious Education is to be in accordance with the teachings, doctrines, discipline and general and particular norms of the Catholic Church;
 - (b) Religious worship is to be in accordance with the rites, practices, discipline and liturgical norms of the Catholic Church;

and at all times the school is to serve as a witness to the Catholic faith in Our Lord Jesus Christ.

- 3. The school is a voluntary aided school
- 4. The name of the governing body is "The Governing Body of St Mary's and St Andrew's Catholic Primary School, Barton Newsham"
- 5. The school was established under the provisions of the Diocesan Trust Deed dated 31 July 1934
- 6. The governing body shall consist of:
 - (a) 8 foundation governors
 - (b) 2 parent governors
 - (c) 1 Authority governor
 - (d) 1 staff governor
 - (e) 1 headteacher governor
 - (f) 1 co-opted governor
- 7. The total number of governors is 14
- 8. Foundation governors are appointed and may be removed by the Bishop of Lancaster (or any other person exercising Ordinary jurisdiction on his behalf)

- 9. The term of office of all governors is 4 years
- 10. This instrument of government comes into effect on 1 March 2015
- 11. This instrument was made by order of Lancashire Local Education Authority on 27 February 2015
- 12. A copy of the instrument must be supplied to every member of the governing body (and the headteacher if not a governor), the Trustees under any Trust Deed and to the appropriate Diocesan Authority.
