INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT: VOLUNTARY AIDED SCHOOL

1. The name of the school is St Mary's and St Andrew's Catholic Primary School, Barton Newsham
2. The school was founded by and is part of the Catholic Church. The school is to be conducted as a Catholic School in accordance with the Canon Law and teachings of the Roman Catholic Church, and in accordance with the Trust Deed of the Diocese of Lancaster and in particular:
 - (a) Religious Education is to be in accordance with the teachings, doctrines, discipline and general and particular norms of the Catholic Church;
 - (b) Religious worship is to be in accordance with the rites, practices, discipline and liturgical norms of the Catholic Church;and at all times the school is to serve as a witness to the Catholic faith in Our Lord Jesus Christ.
3. The school is a voluntary aided school
4. The name of the governing body is "The Governing Body of St Mary's and St Andrew's Catholic Primary School, Barton Newsham"
5. The school was established under the provisions of the Diocesan Trust Deed dated 31 July 1934
6. The governing body shall consist of:
 - (a) 8 foundation governors
 - (b) 2 parent governors
 - (c) 1 Authority governor
 - (d) 1 staff governor
 - (e) 1 headteacher governor
 - (f) 1 co-opted governor
7. The total number of governors is 14
8. Foundation governors are appointed and may be removed by the Bishop of Lancaster (or any other person exercising Ordinary jurisdiction on his behalf)

9. The term of office of all governors is 4 years
10. This instrument of government comes into effect on 1 March 2015
11. This instrument was made by order of Lancashire Local Education Authority on 27 February 2015
12. A copy of the instrument must be supplied to every member of the governing body (and the headteacher if not a governor), the Trustees under any Trust Deed and to the appropriate Diocesan Authority.
